Free parking is available in Whiteman Park. Entry into Whiteman Park is free. Please do not leave valuables in your vehicle.

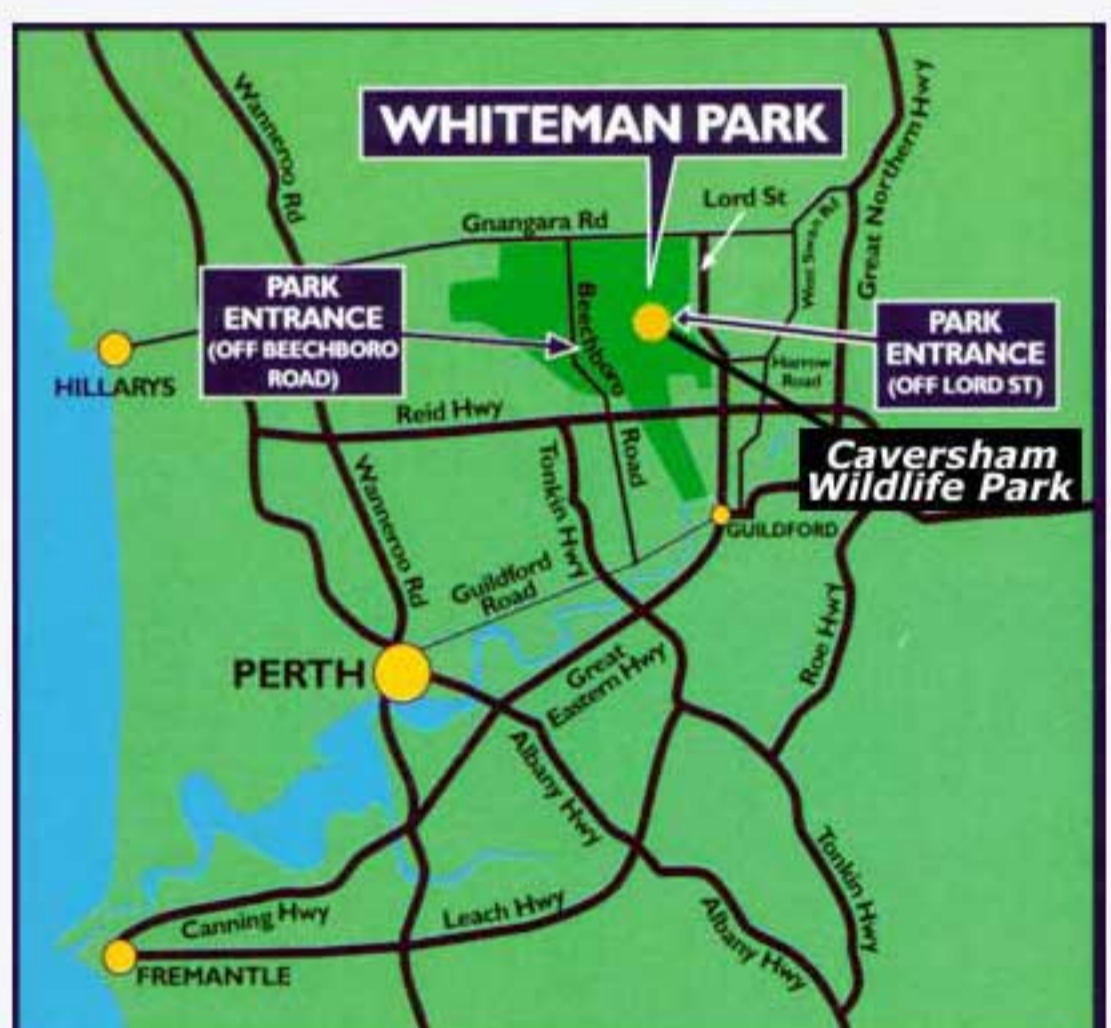
Location

We are located inside Whiteman Park. Please use either Lord Street entrance or Beechboro Road entrance.

Catch a taxi from where you are staying; the driver will know how to get to the park.

Catch a bus from Morley to Ellenbrook. Ask the driver to let you off at Whiteman Park.

The park is wheelchair and pram friendly, with pathways and disabled toilets.

The park is well shaded. Undercover areas are available.
